



Getting to Strahan

By air

Air Connections are via Launceston and Hobart (Qantas, Virgin Blue, Jetstar and Tiger Airways), Devonport and Burnie (Jetstar and Regional Air Express). Tas Air Charter Service is also available from Hobart or Launceston.

By sea

The Spirit of Tasmania I and II sails between Melbourne and Devonport daily.

By road

From southern Tasmania:

The drive between Hobart and Strahan takes about five hours, allowing for a short break at Lake St Clair. Depart Hobart along Brooker Ave through the northern suburbs. At Granton, follow the Lyell Highway (A10) through New Norfolk, Hamilton and Ouse.

From the north of the State:

Head through the Cradle Mountain link road (accessible from Burnie, Devonport or Launceston) and on the A10 through the mining towns of Tullah, Rosebery and Zeehan. Take time to stop and explore these historic landmarks in the West Coast's development through more than 100 years of mining and Hydro-electric schemes.
