



Preparing for Freycinet

Weather

Average temperatures in summer sit at a balmy 22 degrees, perfect for winding up, winding down, heading out or even staying still on your balcony at Freycinet Lodge.

Maximum rainfall is about 47mm in October, the perfect excuse to sit inside with a glass of fine Tasmanian wine and take in the breath-taking views, or take part in one of the Freycinet Lodge's many indoor activities.

What to bring

If you are travelling light, items such as jackets and coats can be purchased in our Freycinet Lodge retail outlet. Sturdy walking boots are highly recommended to take in the best parts of Freycinet by foot.

No permanent water supply exists in the park, and it is advised that you carry at least one litre per person for any walk – even a short one. Weather conditions can change rapidly, so it is also advisable to carry a jacket or jumper as well as a hat and sun-block.
