



Preparing for Strahan

Weather

Average summer temperatures peak at about 21.5 degrees, with about 200mm of rainfall – more than essential for the survival of this region. In winter, temperatures can get down to about 5.5 degrees, with a maximum of about 13 degrees, and 550-650mm of rain.

What to bring

It is not unusual to experience four seasons in one day at Strahan – from blazing sunshine to soaking rain. You should not be surprised or disappointed by the rain here, for this is the climate that has formed this spectacular World Heritage rainforest.

Hats, coats, jumpers, sturdy shoes and, in winter, gloves and scarves, are all recommended to ensure you get the best out of this wild wilderness, for getting out amongst the elements is one of its most charming attractions.
